



1) ALL enrolling students must complete and submit the following registration forms. For families enrolling multiple students or siblings, please fill out all registration forms for **each** enrolled student—payment information can be listed on just one form.

3) Paying by check: Please include your full tuition check or \$250.00 deposit check with your mailed in registration forms. All checks made payable to Peacock Players—please write your student(s) name on the check memo line. If enrolling with a \$250 deposit check, the remaining balance is due by July 2nd.

4) Paying by credit card (online only): Please click the payment button located on our website's Summer Theatre Camp page (www.peacockplayers.org). And remember, you must submit your completed registration forms (steps 1 & 2 above). Please note: online credit card payments are full tuition only—\$250.00 deposits must be paid by check and mailed in.

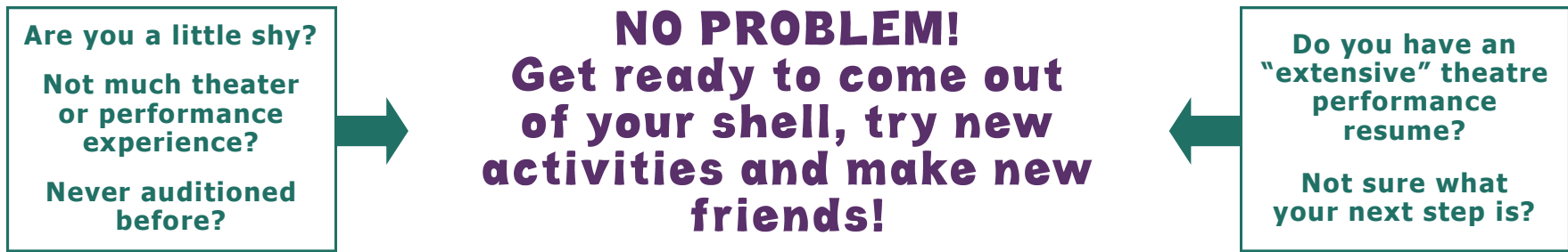

Professional Selection

Peacock Players is deeply committed to fair, unbiased, casting procedures, and takes great pride in providing selective casting to better educate and prepare our students to the realities of professional theatre. In our Mainstage productions, not every person that auditions is cast, however we hold strongly to the belief that each and every audition opportunity is an honest educational experience – whatever the result. This type of professional audition process benefits the individual artist and their ability to accept and learn from each audition, whether the student is a career-bound artist or a recreational theatre enthusiast.

In our SUMMER THEATRE CAMP showcase productions, every camper that wants to audition will be cast, however not every camper can be cast in a leading role (obviously). Camp showcases are cast accordingly using the same professional standard we employ on Mainstage—to best serve the project.

Casting of actors is carefully evaluated on the basis of the individual acting, singing, and dancing skills demonstrated during the audition process; as well as on the actor’s appropriateness and suitability for the specific roles required to serve each project.
